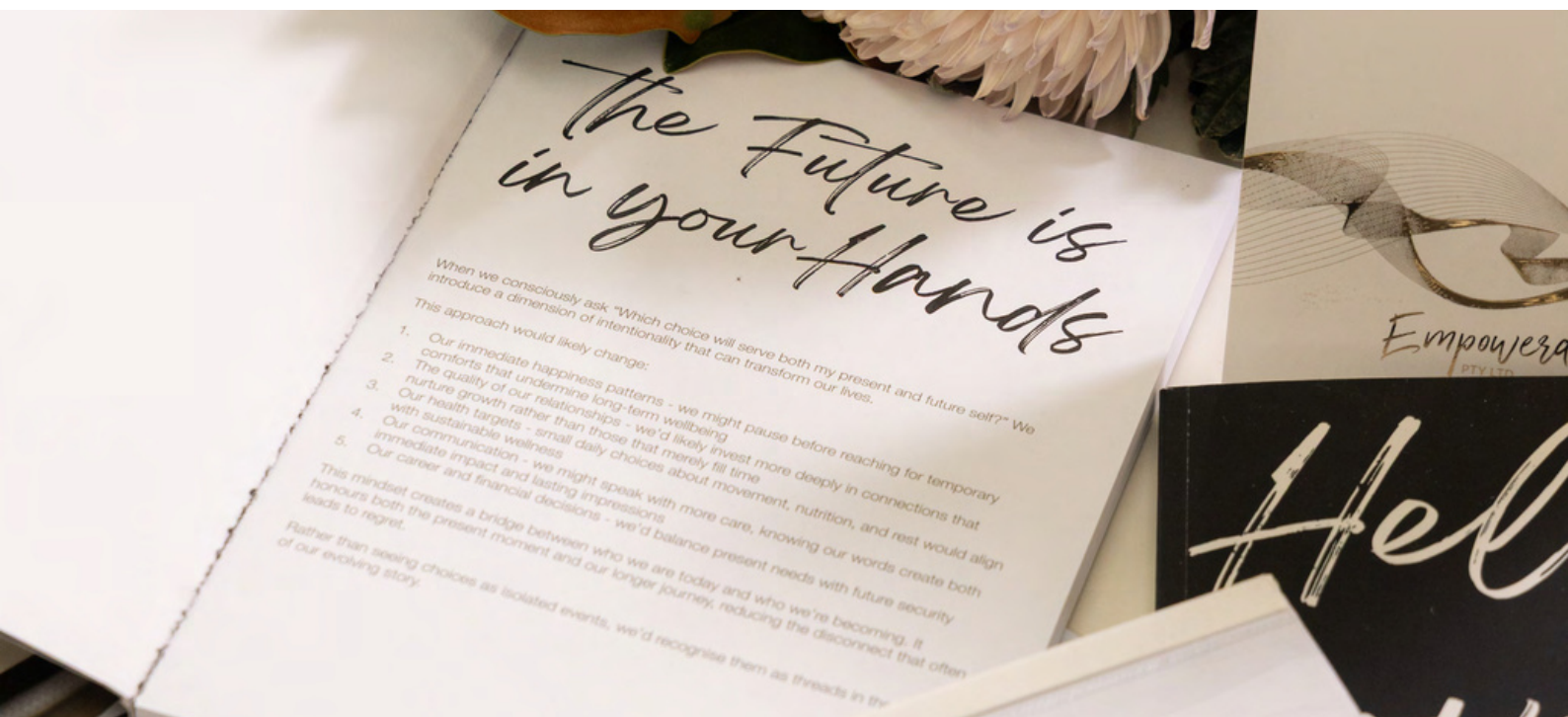

ASSESSMENTS INFORMATION

The choice of assessment methods is flexible and is determined by the course coordinator to best accommodate students' participation and RTO timetable scheduling.
